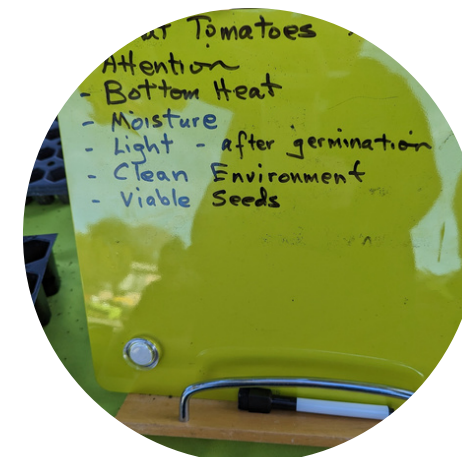

GENERAL FUND OPERATING ACCOUNT (CITIBANK XXX561)

- **USED FOR CLUB AND GARDEN OPERATIONAL EXPENSES**
- **CURRENT BALANCE (DECEMBER OUTSTANDING): \$21,530**
 - **2023 Income: \$16,902**
 - **2023 Expenses: \$13,022**
 - **Net gain of \$3,880**

RESTRICTED FUND RESERVED ACCOUNT (CITIBANK XXX475)

- **INCOME SOURCE IS GRANTS AND DONATIONS**
- **USED FOR EXPENSES THAT ARE TIED TO GRANTS AND BOARD APPROVED LARGE PROJECTS**
- **CURRENT BALANCE IS \$35,299.53 (\$10,000 IS HELD ON DEPOSIT FOR COWEN)**

TREASURER'S REPORT

OUTLOOK FOR 2024

FINANCIALLY HAVE ASSETS TO CARRY THE CLUB ONE YEAR, BUT DO NOT HAVE A BALANCED OPERATING BUDGET AT THIS TIME

- **Income projection: \$13,600 (dependent on one fundraiser netting \$3,000 – no fundraiser \$10,600**
- **Expense projection: \$18,100**
- **Shortfall: \$4,500 (meaning we would eat into our savings) – no fundraiser \$7,500**
- **2024 Board will be challenged to develop a balanced budget and operate within the means of the budget**
- **Balance in General fund operating account should not be used to handle annual operations**

CONTINUE FUNDRAISING

- **All plotholders would be required to participate**

RAISE PLOT FEES

- **Club subsidizes plot fees**
- **Minimum basic expenses to operate plots including insurance and utilities = \$7,500/yr**
- **Income generated from plot fees: \$5,130/yr**
- **Shortfall: \$2,370, subsidized by the fundraisers**
- **Plot fee increase would MINIMALLY be appx \$63/yr per based on full plot, raising plot fees from \$135 to appx \$198/yr**

The Governance Committee provides oversight of agreements, insurance and consistency of governing documents (procedures, policies and guidelines) while guiding the administration of board directives.

For 2023, Governance helped the club make several modifications to our governing documents:

- **The dates of the annual meeting and beginning day of the new board were modified in the By Laws**
- **The Leave of Absence Policy was modified and the applicable Guideline updated**
- **The Gardening Guidelines were rewritten and divided into three documents:**

 - **Separate Enforcement Policy (for all Guidelines)**
